About Next Gen HCBS Leaders Program

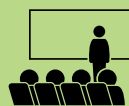
To encourage up-and-coming professionals to seek senior leadership opportunities in LTSS state agencies, ADvancing States is excited to provide a unique opportunity for emerging leaders, the Next Gen HCBS Leaders Program (Next Gen). The Next Gen program offers a combination of networking and learning opportunities with a curriculum tailored to those wishing to deepen their knowledge and refine their skills in management, leadership, and content development in the Medicaid and Aging arenas.

During each one-year program, Next Gen Leaders receive 1:1 mentorship from an expert in their field, access to exclusive educational opportunities, including an overview of how aging and disability services are provided throughout the nation, and scholarships to the ADvancing States' Spring Meeting and HCBS Conference, where they can network with and learn from leaders across the country. Next Gen Leaders also have the opportunity to participate in the Foundational Leadership in HCBS training program, a first-of-its-kind learning opportunity offered in partnership with the Gillings School of Public Health at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill.

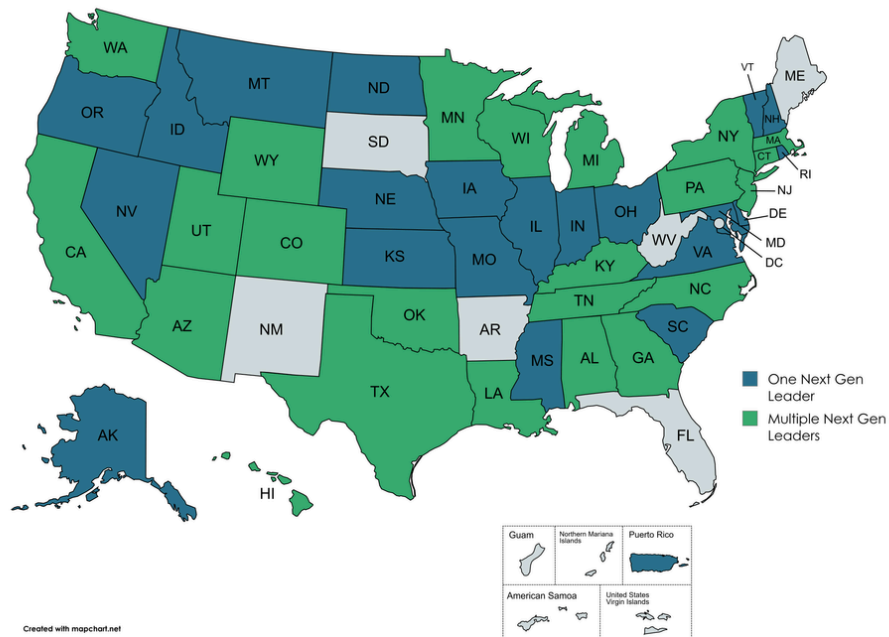

Interest in the Next Gen HCBS Leaders program has been high and is increasing as the program matures. Since its program launch in 2022, more than 300 people have applied to participate in the program and thanks to the generosity of the Next Gen sponsors, dozens of Next Gen HCBS Leaders have completed the program.

Each cohort of 15 Next Gen Leaders represent state and territorial agencies on aging and disabilities from across the country.

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Foundational Leadership in HCBS

We're excited to celebrate a groundbreaking addition to the Next Gen Leaders experience — the **Foundational Leadership in HCBS** training program, offered in partnership with the prestigious **Gillings School of Global Public Health at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill**.

This first-of-its-kind program provides Next Gen Leaders with an opportunity to build their expertise to better support people in their homes and communities through a structured, interactive curriculum. Participants receive scholarships to cover program costs and over the course of a 10-week, asynchronous training, learn about populations utilizing LTSS, organizations and individuals providing LTSS, and the varied sources of funding for LTSS with an emphasis on HCBS.

- **Barriers and Opportunities in HCBS**
