

### How many family caregivers does your coalition serve, on average, each year?








### Current Survey Responses

## Community Services Coalition Example: Reach Out Morongo Basin (29 Palms, CA)



Reach Out Morongo Basin
Neighbors Helping Neighbors

- Matches volunteers with seniors for help with activities of daily living
- Worked with local military base to link volunteer Marines to service days
- Members include local community and faithbased organizations

- Uses 20 Central Texas non-profits to pool support and resources for caregivers and families
- Offers education (Powerful Tools for Caregivers) and conferences, free for caregivers

- Strong online presence





## Organizational Goal Setting



### Strategic Planning: S.M.A.R.T. Goals

### S.M.A.R.T. goals are:

- **S**pecific
- Measureable
- Achievable
- Realistic
- Timely

### Example:

ABC Coalition will host a monthly caregiver support group, on the first Monday at 7pm at the Lion's Club.
Success will be measured by number of attendees and quality of caregiver engagement. The program will launch January 2015.

### Amplifying Your Coalition's Voice

Loosely caregorganized fundersupport common partners

Formal 501(c)(3) that supports 100+ local caregivers, funded by community partners

Identification of state laws or municipal regulations that can support family caregivers (such as flexible work policies)

# Advocacy Coalition Example: New Mexico Direct Caregiving Coalition





- "Listening Sessions" with local lawmakers, family caregivers and direct care workers
- Used to build and identify a policy agenda, attract new advocates, and empower caregivers



# Advocacy Coalition Example: Hawaii Family Caregiver Coalition





- State Legislature Visits
- Annual Caregiver Day at the State Capitol
- Annual Aging & Disabilities Issues guidebook
- Work to support the "CARE Act" to assist families at hospital discharge
