

Strategic Integration Between State Staff and EQRO Partner

- Ongoing meetings
- Feedback loops
- Honest conversations to get it "right", even if we need to go back to the drawing board
- The annual scope of work is planned in advance

MLTSS Over- / Under-Utilization Focused Study



Conducted post MLTSS implementation to determine changes in HCBS service authorizations

Helpful in identifying opportunities to standardize MCO assessment processes and tools

Identified opportunities for targeted education around services such as respite care and home modifications



- requirements are consistent throughout program documents


