Our panelists represent 3 of the 26 tribal nations working on MFPTI

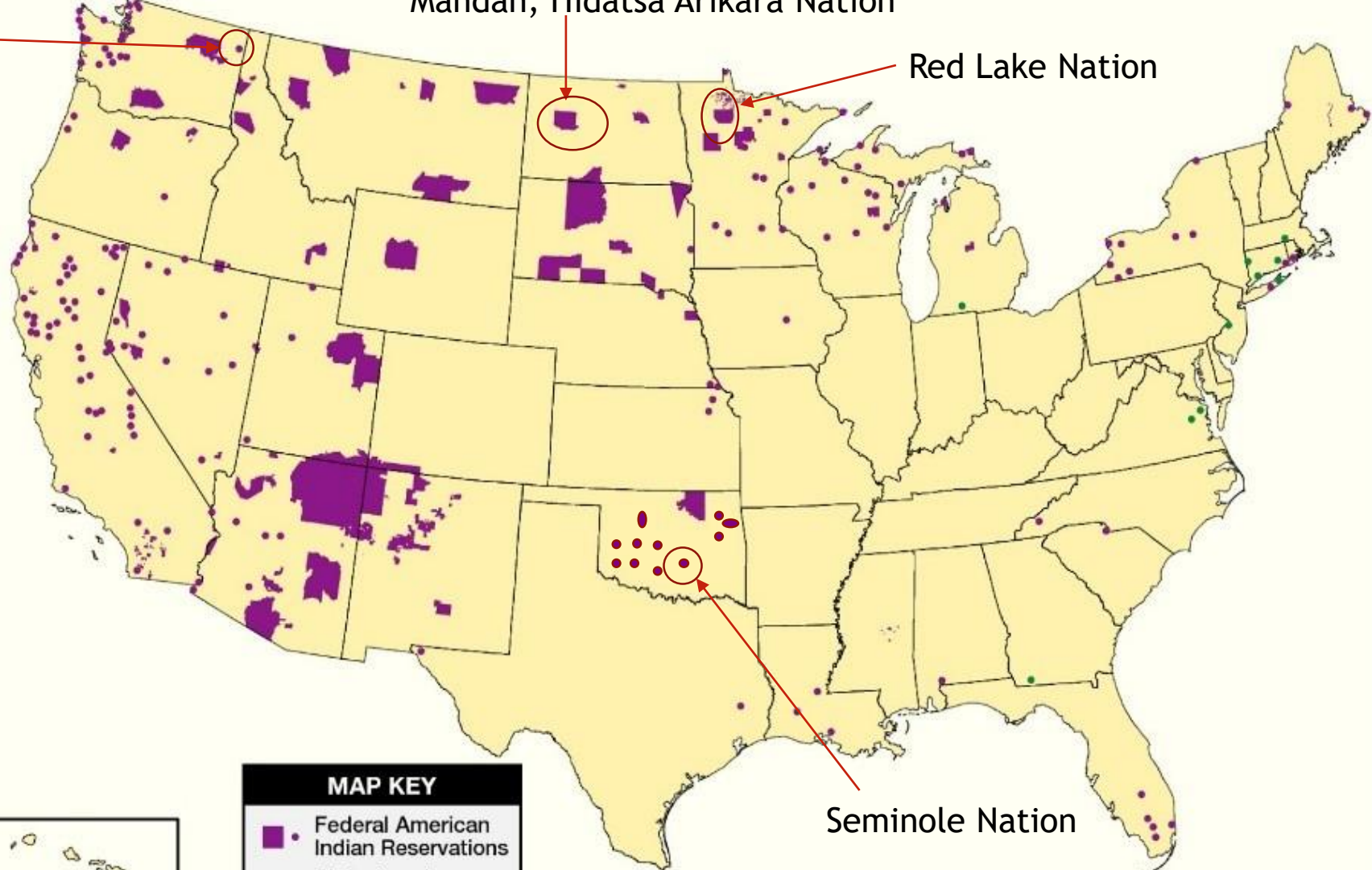
